- Timetables have been issued & you have your seats for each exam written down in your planner
- Intensity – this will be a tough week
- Repeat – of what you did in Y10 and you will have further mocks in March
- Re-create the full GCSE experience

- Each day you will line up in row and seat number order **after the whole school morning line up**. Rows are labelled on the fence to help you
- The line should be single file and silent
- A register will be taken either in line up or by a member of SLT in the cage
- If you do not have an exam you will be directed where to go

- You will be escorted to St Cuthberts Hall by staff



Whilst walking to St Cuthberts...

- Staff will lead – you must not be ahead of your supervising member of staff
- Walk in single file
- Perfect uniform & behaviour
- **RESPECT** for other people (members of the public)
- **HIGH EXPECTATIONS** of all of you as ambassadors for the school
- Take the time to focus on the upcoming exam
- 13mins from leaving BFS to starting the exam

Arrival at St Cuthberts

- Line up in single file along the wall as directed
- Enter the hall and leave bags where directed
- Phones switched off and in bags
- Ensure you have all equipment needed (BLACK PEN clear pencil case/sandwich bag). **Please note, no spare equipment will be provided – make sure you have what you need!**
- Once you enter the exam hall, you are in exam conditions (total silence, no communication, raise your hand if you need an invigilator's attention)

RESPECT/HONESTY/HIGH EXPECTATIONS

Leaving St Cuthberts

- You will be escorted back by staff in the same way (single file **RESPECT, HIGH EXPECTATIONS**)
- When you arrive back at school you will return to lessons
- **You will** have the option to go home from St Cuthberts following **afternoon** exams. If you wish to/need to return to school e.g. for a lift/sibling/HW Club you will be able to do so
